NAME OF ORDER: Order of the Good Samaritans for Youth

PURPOSE OF ORDER: To care for those in need—physical need, spiritual need, and emotional need. To provide care, comfort, and compassion to souls suffering from life and death emergencies, and to souls who are psychologically burdened.

SPONSORING ASCENDED MASTER: El Morya

RAYS OF SERVICE: This Order is on the First Ray of the will of God, the Fifth Ray of healing and the Seventh Ray of freedom and alchemy.

PRAYER SERVICE: Decrees and one call daily for a hurting soul. Decrees, prayers or meditations of your choice. May choose to attend Wednesday evening healing service, *Watch with Me!* Jesus Vigil of the Hours. and/or the Tuesday Evening Vigil to El Morya.

CHARITY WORK:

- Offer charity work of your choice. This can be offered within your own family, community, or within the outer community in your local city.
- Volunteer to help life in every capacity when possible, such as serving in a soup line, visiting the elderly or Humane Societies.
- Youth members may join Boy and/or Girl Scouts.
- Volunteer to assist leading a Boy or Girls Scout troop to set a good example.

ORDER OF THE GOOD SAMARITAN FOR YOUTH GUIDELINES

“I AM *on Call* because I AM the Good Samaritan” El Morya, October 7, 1984

- Ancient order sponsored by Ascended Master El Morya and dedicated to the Will of God.
- Membership open to all youth who meet the requirements of this order:
 - 1) Members are current in First Aid and CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation) certification.
 - 2) Members meet the requirement of having the spirit of the “perpetual helper” that acknowledges that the comfort flame of the Holy Spirit comes through the Sons and Daughters of God in embodiment.
 - 3) Learn Foot Reflexology. “This treatment can give relief to anyone.” It is a safe form of treatment. **(Optional)**
- Members have the opportunity to be a ministering servant and to demonstrate love and service and care and to learn more about themselves and others.

PURPOSE

- To care for those in need—physical need, spiritual need, and emotional need.
- To provide care, comfort, and compassion to souls suffering from life and death emergencies, and to souls who are psychologically burdened.

MISSION STATEMENT AND VISION STATEMENT

- **Mission Statement:** “A Good Samaritan helps those in need.”
- **Vision Statement:** By helping those in need spiritually, physically and emotionally I have become the Good Samaritan. I am dedicated to God’s Will that not one of His little ones should be lost. Therefore, I keep myself strong and healthy spiritually, physically and emotionally so I am ready to meet the challenges of life to be ready to help others in need. I am the Good Samaritan and I am dedicated to God’s Will.

WAY OF LIFE

- Based on Saint Germain’s ideals when he sponsored the founding of the Boy and Girl Scouts of America. A Good Samaritan youth’s motto is to “Be Prepared,” for whatever comes his or her way by learning all they can. To keep strong, healthy and ready to meet the challenges of life. Other goals of a Good Samaritan youth are to be: Compassionate, Trustworthy, loyal, helpful, friendly, courteous, kind, obedient, cheerful, joyful, thrifty, brave, clean, reverent, and a ministering servant dedicated to the Will of God.

- An order of qualified youth whose goal is to be the perpetual helper in service to the causes of the First Ray of the Will of God and the Seventh Ray of Freedom and Divine Justice.
- The way of the Good Samaritan is to be prepared and to be on hand in emergencies of life and death.
- Those identify themselves not only as their brother's keeper but also as the Good Samaritan—at all times, twenty-four hours a day.
- Keep current on First Aid and CPR certification.

RECOMMENDED PRAYERS, DECREES, AND MEDITATIONS

- Decree and give one call daily for a hurting soul.
- Choose other decrees, prayers or meditations.

BOOKS TO STUDY

- *The Sacred Adventure*, by El Morya.

PLEDGE OR VOW

- I vow to do a good turn daily.

CHARITY WORK

- Charity work of your choice. Can be within your family, community or within the outer community in your local city.
- Volunteer to help life in every capacity when possible, such as serving in a soup line, visiting the elderly or Humane Societies.
- Youth members may join Boy and/or Girl Scouts.
- Volunteer to assist leading a Boy or Girls Scout troop to set a good example.

TEACHINGS OF THE ASCENDED MASTERS:

The Order of the Good Samaritan is an ancient order headed by El Morya, dedicated to the Will of God. El Morya says the following about this Order:

“Long ago I was called to be head of the Order of the Good Samaritans, and this I have told you,¹² and it was a part of my service and initiation on the path of the will of God. For when one pursues the will of God, one must always discover that it is not His will that any of His little ones should be lost.” [El Morya, 10-7-84]

“...the Order of Samaria (the Good Samaritans) of which I have been master for centuries.” [El Morya in “A Report,” n.p.]

“It is a mighty order at inner levels. I come forth as the head of that order because I am the one who trains the troops. Once you have mastered what I have to give you and to teach you, beloved hearts, you will also walk as the brother and sister of Christ, needing me no longer, for you shall have become truly the heart and essence of the will of God.” [El Morya, 10-7-84]

Requirements/required training:

“Inasmuch, then, as those who live in the physical octave cannot be found again from the state of being lost and pursue their salvation without their physical bodies, the first requirement of the Good Samaritan is to care for those in need—physical need, spiritual need, emotional need—to provide care and comfort and compassion, to go forth and to be able to intelligently help souls who are suffering from whatever dire accident or affliction has befallen them, and to be sensitive to the fact that many suffer extreme burdens of a psychological nature who also must be tended.” [El Morya, 10-7-84]

“We have summoned you, then, to this seminar that you might learn the very first steps—such as first aid, such as training in CPR (cardiopulmonary resuscitation)—that you might understand that the way of the Good Samaritan is to be on hand in emergencies of life and death. We have seen that this course has enabled many to save life, to restore one who could live to think again about God, to become humbled for the miracle and opportunity extended, pulling that one back from the very grips of the toiler of death.

“We have seen, therefore, what good karma ordinary and extraordinary men and women have made by assisting those who are burdened, helpless, and dying. We have seen, beloved hearts, in successive stages the alleviation of burden through other means of healing, which we also outline as prerequisites for membership in the Order of the Good Samaritan—which we therefore in this hour entrust to this organization, to this staff—as a religious order of lay brothers and sisters who will identify themselves not only as their brother’s keeper but as the Good Samaritan—at all times, twenty-four hours a day, responding to the call as those on duty in the fire station, on the police force, the paramedics, those who deal with emergencies in hospitals, identifying oneself always *on call*:

“I AM *on Call* because I AM the Good Samaritan!”

[El Morya, 10-7-84]

“...the Order of the Good Samaritans in the physical octave, having the same sponsorship and endowment as the Church Universal and Triumphant, gives to many who are not yet prepared to be ministers in the full sense of the word the opportunity to demonstrate love and service and care and to learn more about themselves and others. Thus, we see as a great means in the efficacy of the caring for the sick what shall be known as the Good Samaritan Foot Reflexology Course, to be taught here by those who have the skill and have prepared themselves to do so.” [El Morya, 10-7-84]

This Order is for Youth:

“Beloved ones, when you consider the founding of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl Scouts under the sponsorship of Saint Germain, you will realize that our Order of the Good Samaritan is an order of service for adults and those younger ones who may qualify themselves. And in its goals it is much like that of the Boy and Girl Scouts. The order, therefore, takes Boy Scouts and Girl Scouts trained to “Be Prepared” to the full maturity of a continuing life of service as Eagle Scouts and beyond—truly as the perpetual Helper.”

Notes:

(1) The 10-7-84 dictation by El Morya and Jesus contains a lot of additional instruction on this order and on the path of the ministering servant.

(2) The Order of the Good Samaritan has been active for years, largely in the context of SU; CDW personnel trained Keepers/students in the skills required by El Morya for membership in the order and certified them for membership. Mother usually initiated new Good Samaritans at the conclusion of their training and gave additional instruction on the order.
